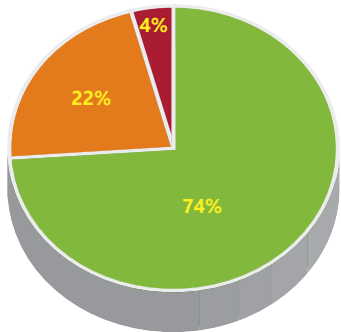


Industry Scope

Citrus remains the country’s largest agricultural export sector by value and provides employment to 140,000 people at farm level.

South Africa exported 203.9 million 15 kg cartons of citrus in 2025 – the highest ever recorded. That’s roughly 3.06 million tonnes, making it a landmark season for the industry.

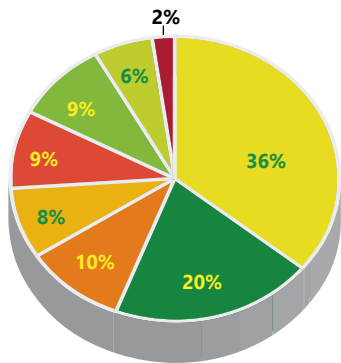

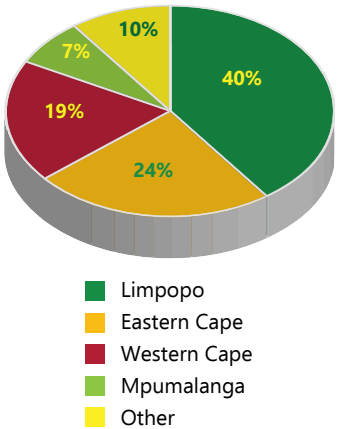

The unique and remarkably complex aroma and smell of citrus fruits are due to a complex mixture of hundreds of volatile organic compounds primarily in the peel. This scent is a key adaptation to attract animals for seed dispersal and nowadays used in perfumes and cosmetics.



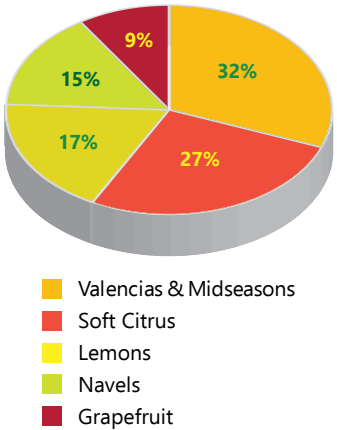

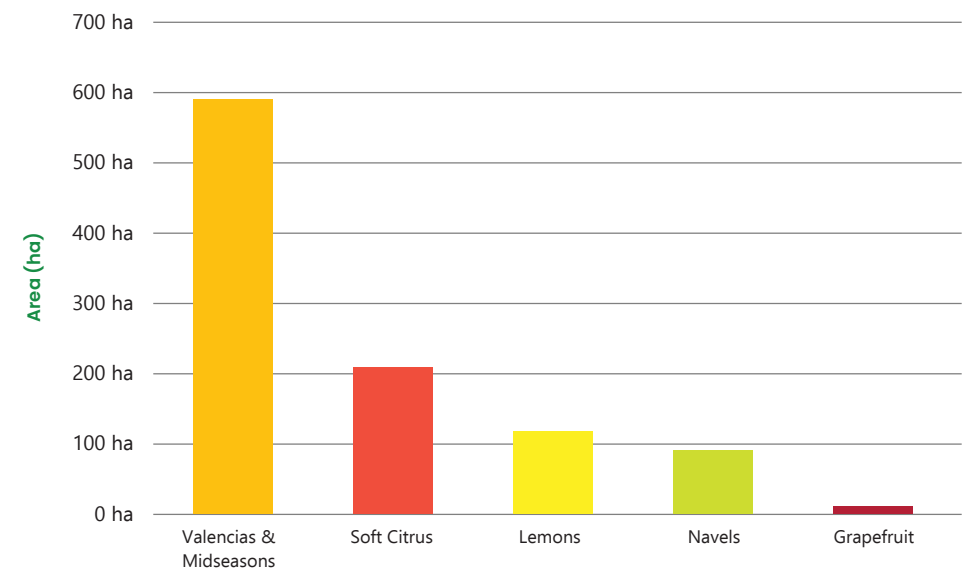

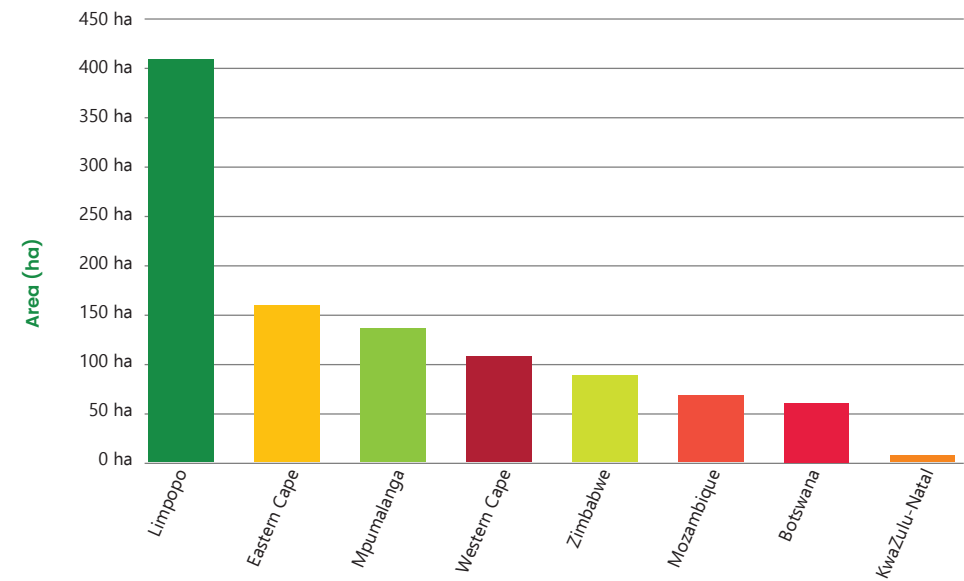

New Plantings by Citrus Type



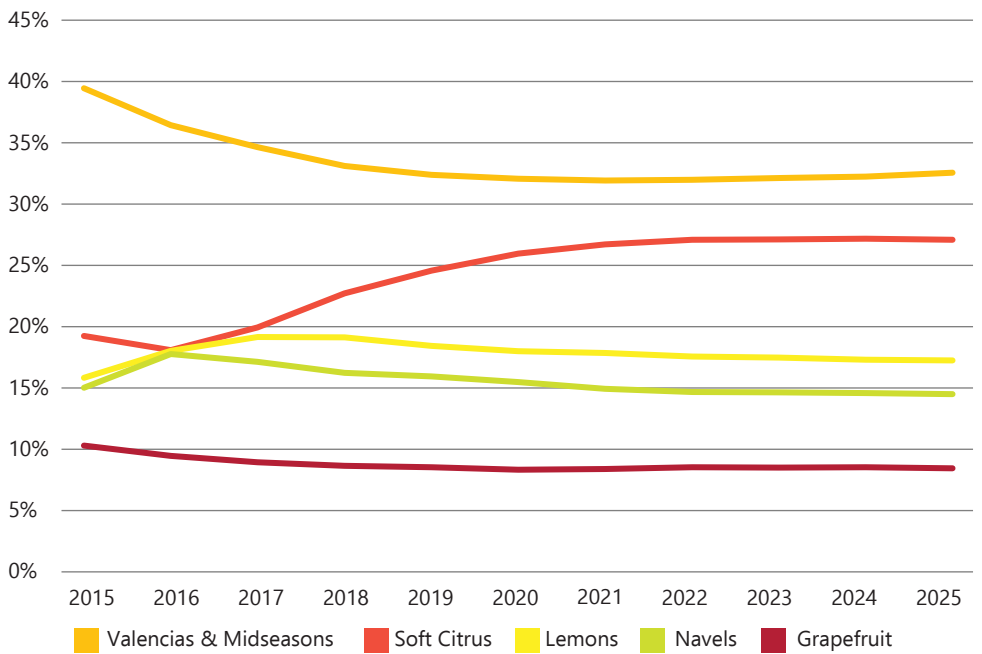

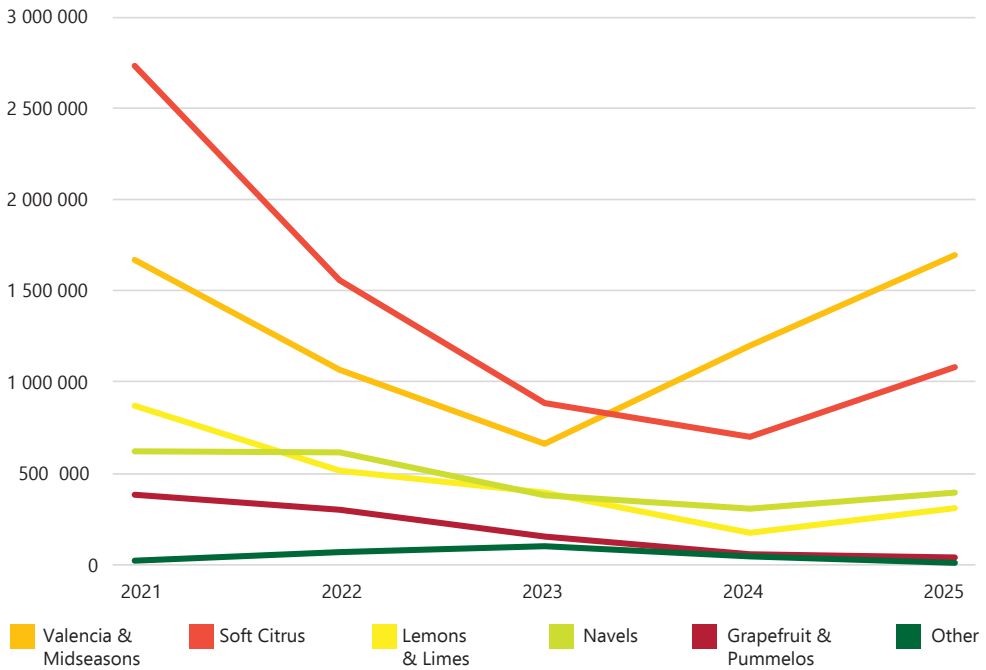
Percentage Share of Total Hectare

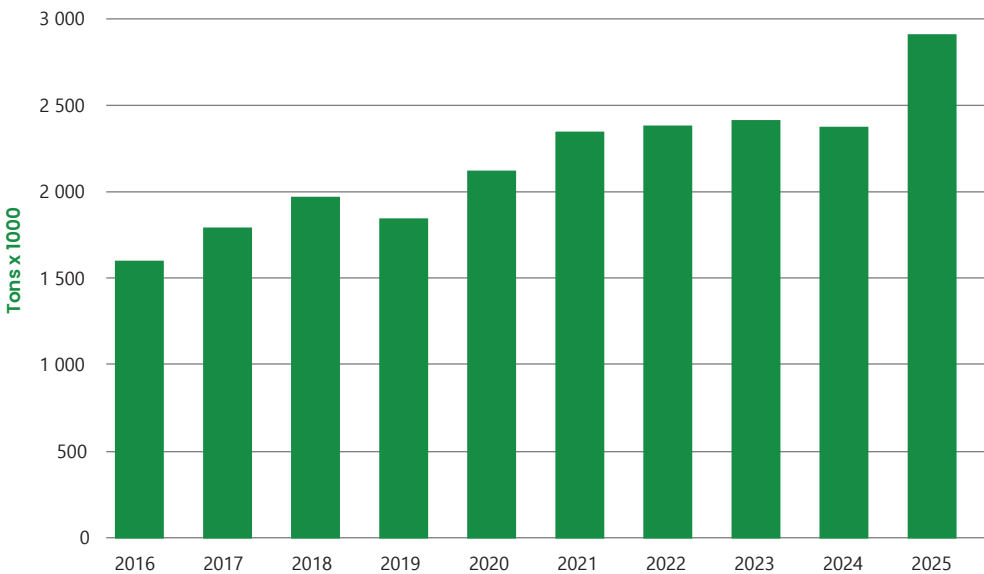

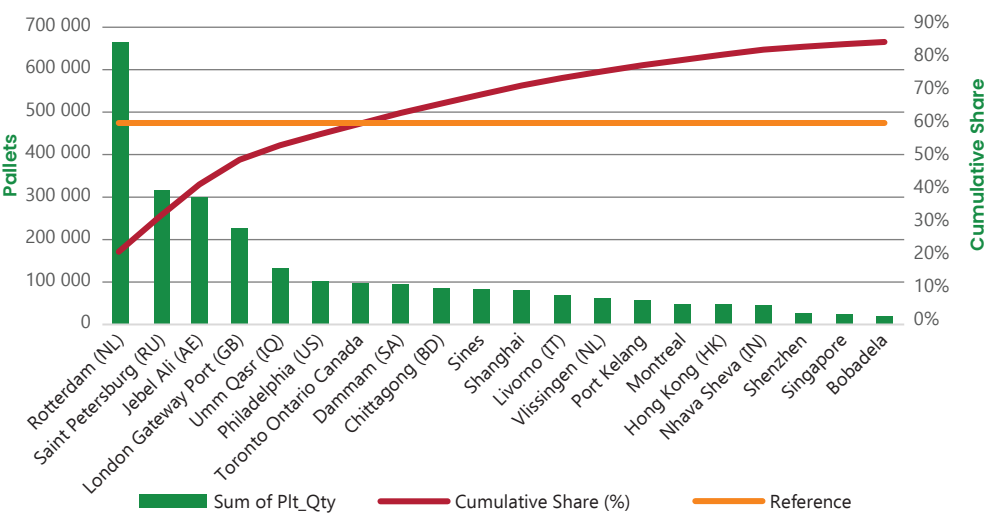

Cumulative Share of Exports by Destination Port (Top 20 ports)

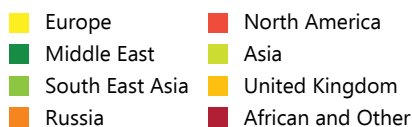
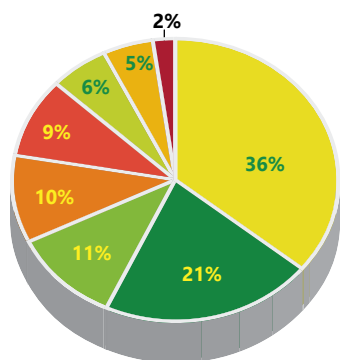

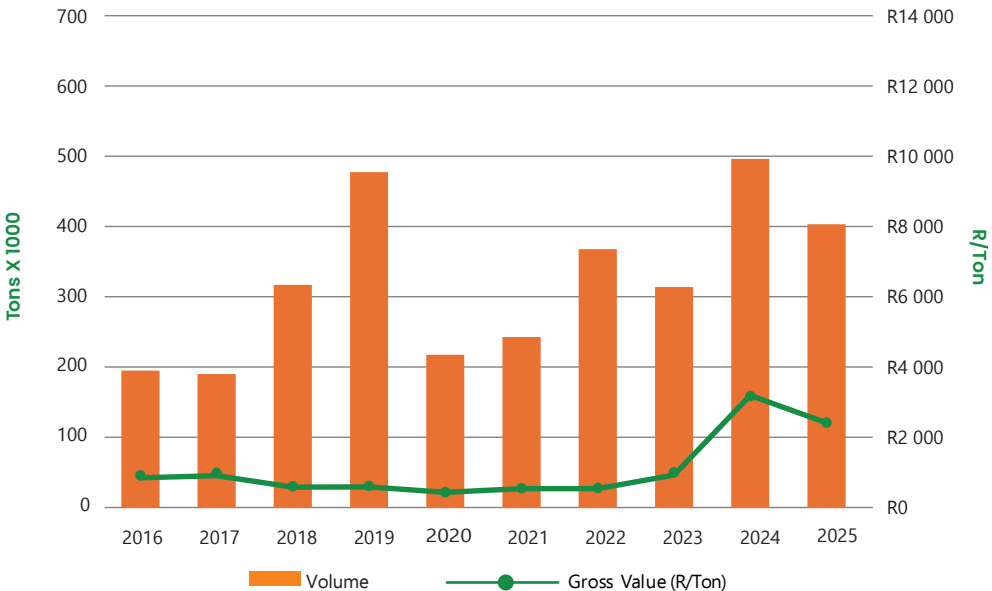
Historical Sales – Local Market

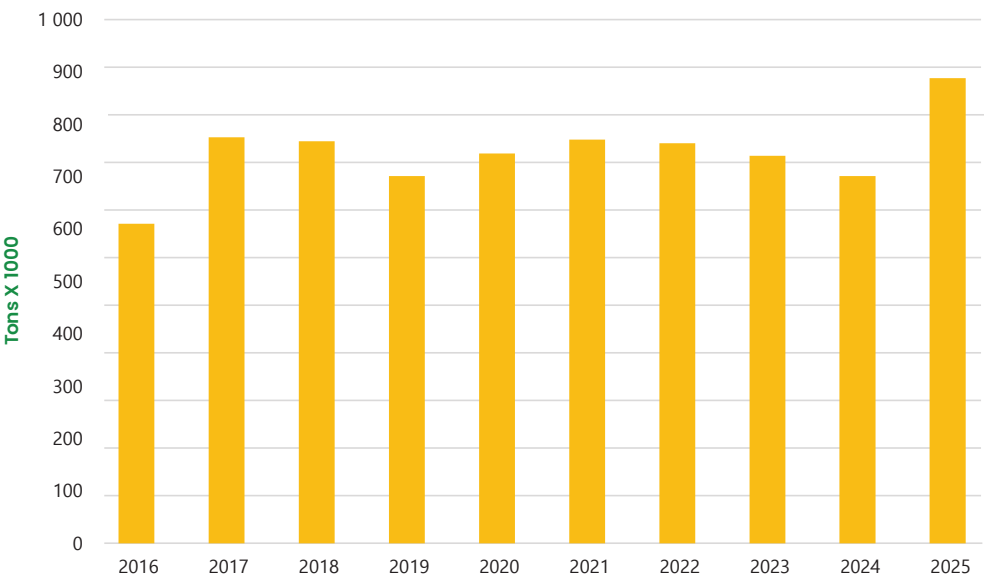

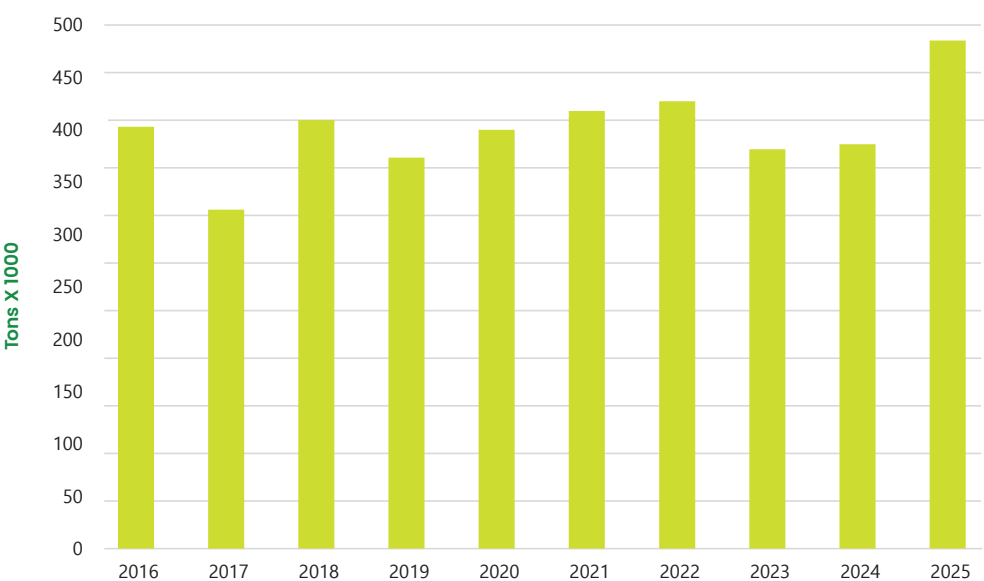

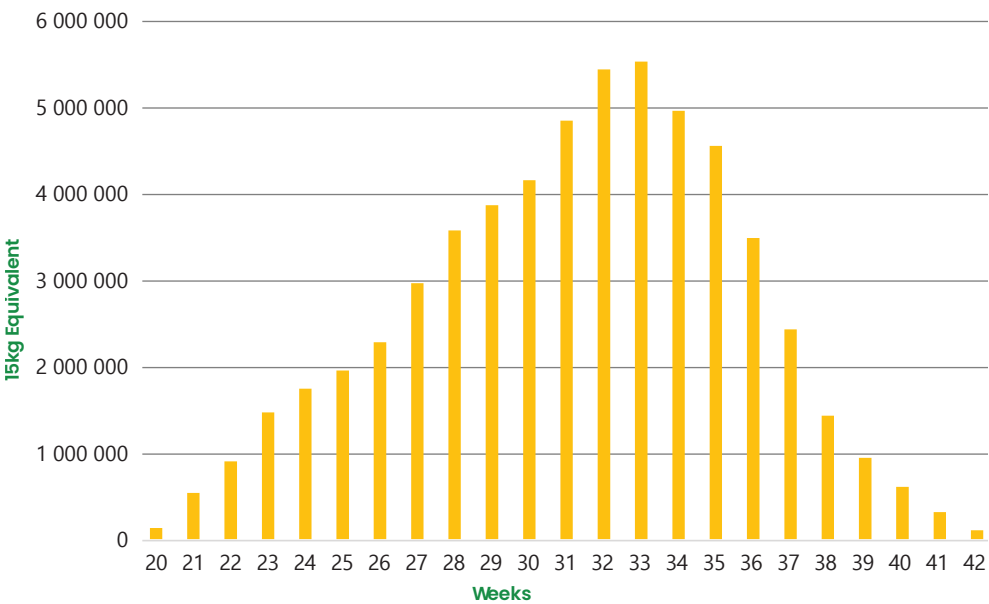
Historical Passed for Exports – Valencias



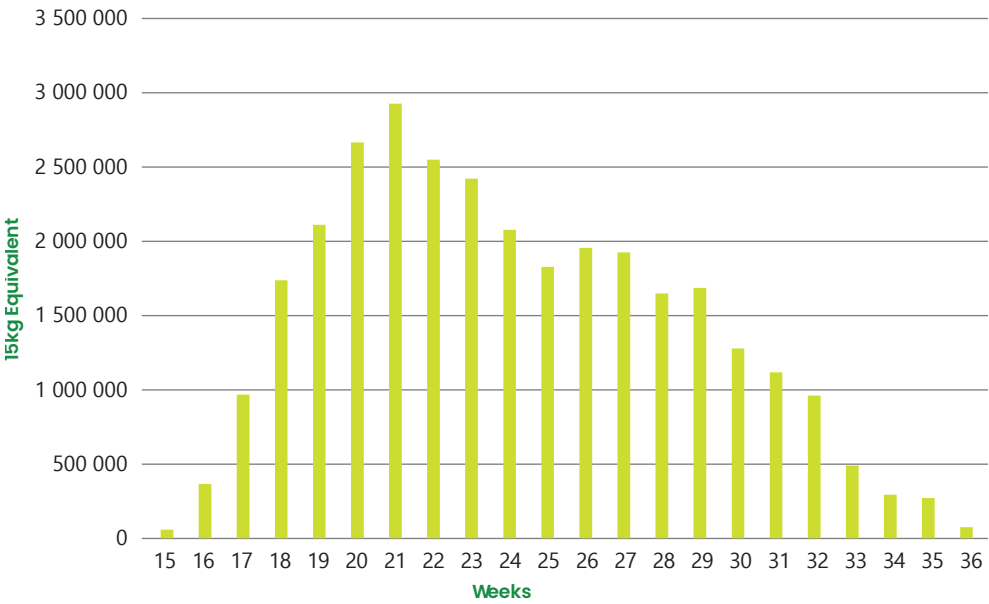
Historical Passed for Exports – Navels



Passed for Exports by Week - Valencias

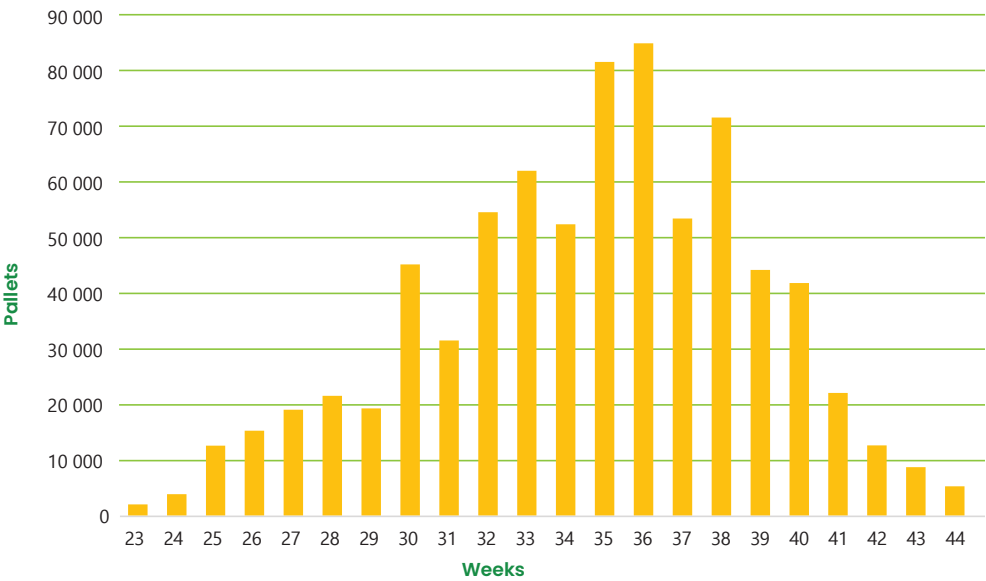


Passed for Exports by Week - Navels

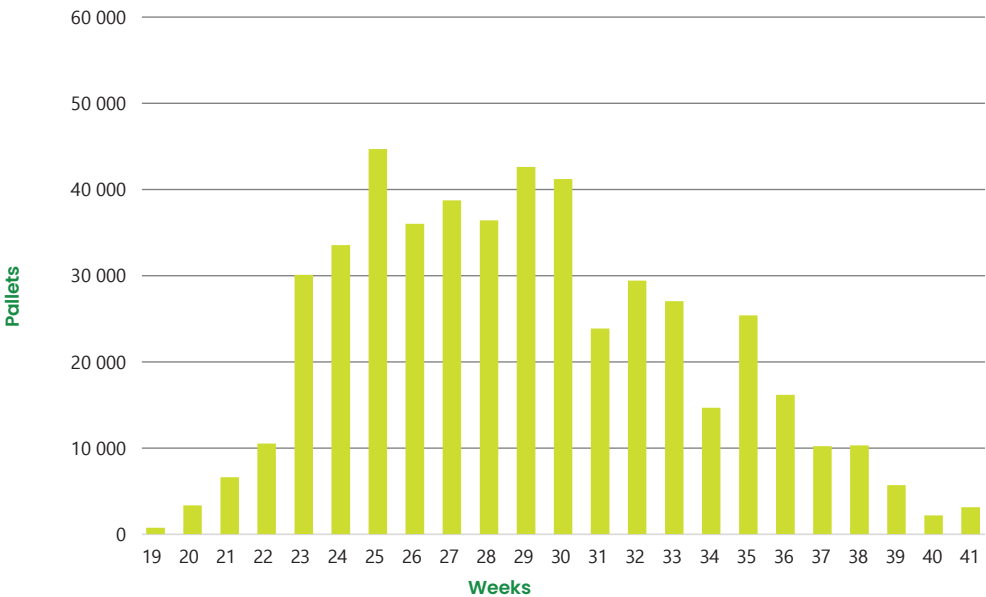

Shipped by Week - Valencia's

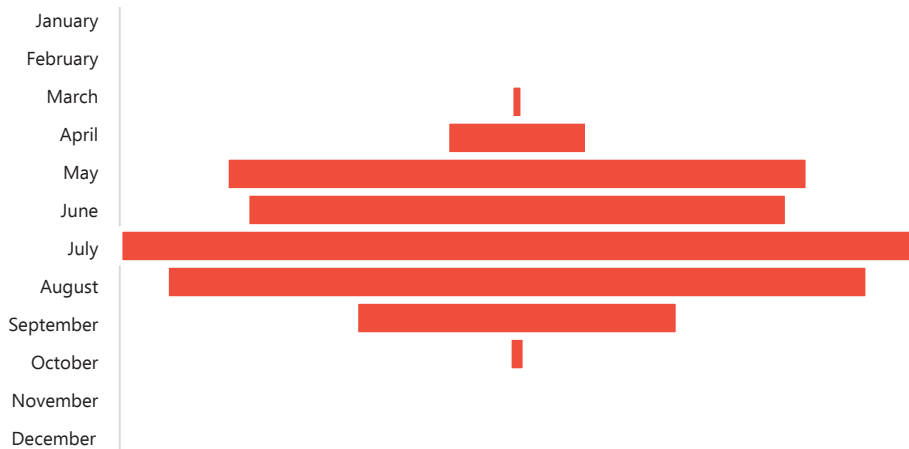

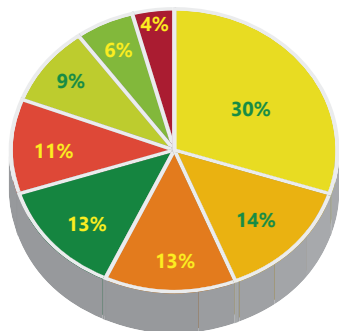

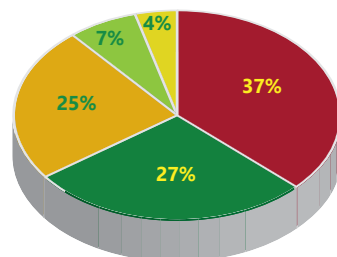

Soft Citrus are unique in their ease of peeling and have branching or reticulating vascular bundles which appear as “strings” on the outer segment walls after peeling. These bundles are responsible for the transport of nutrients and water to the juice vesicles. The branching of these bundles explains the species name for mandarins, *Citrus reticulata*.

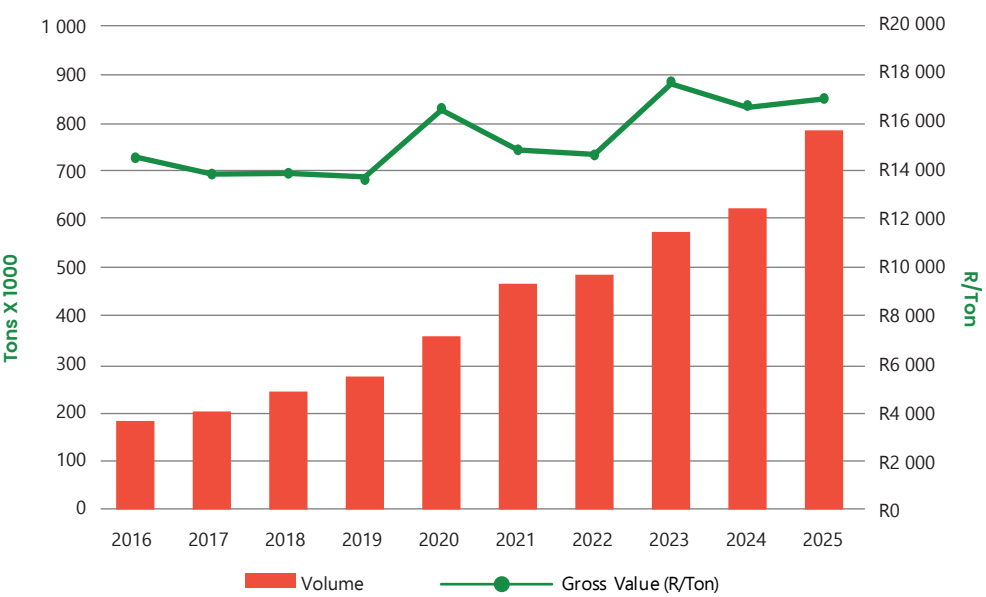

Historical Passed for Exports – Grapefruit



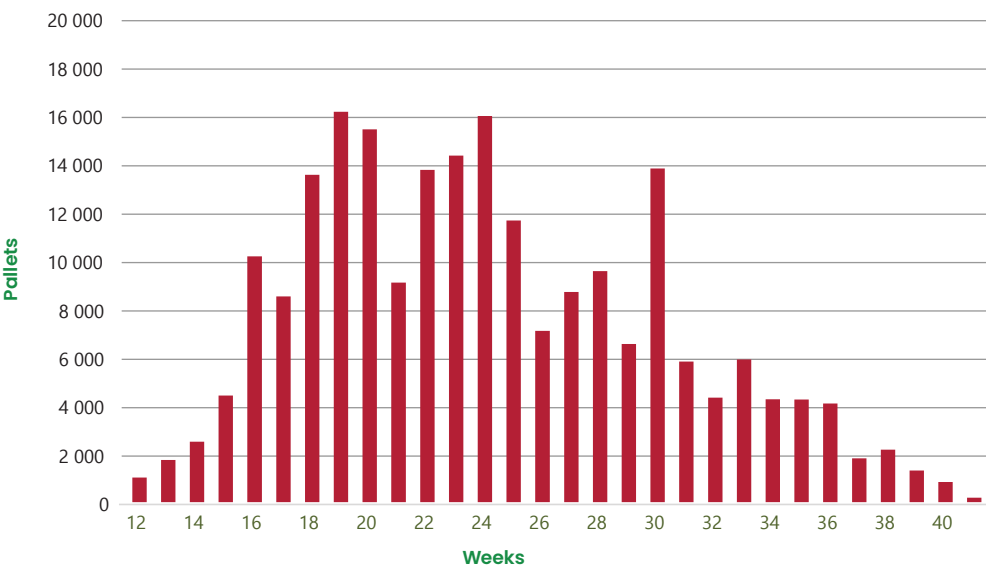

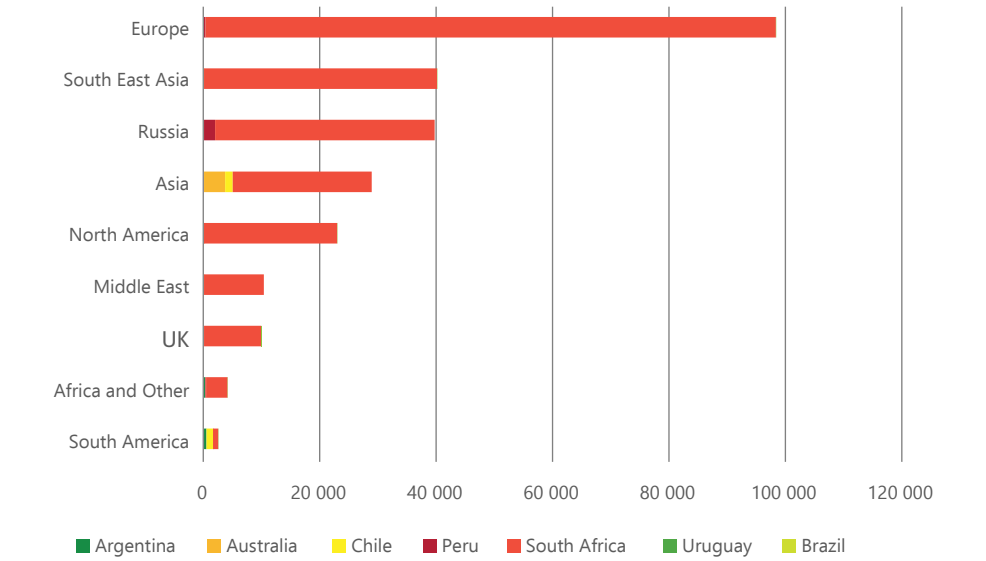
Southern Hemisphere Oranges to Major Export Markets: 2025



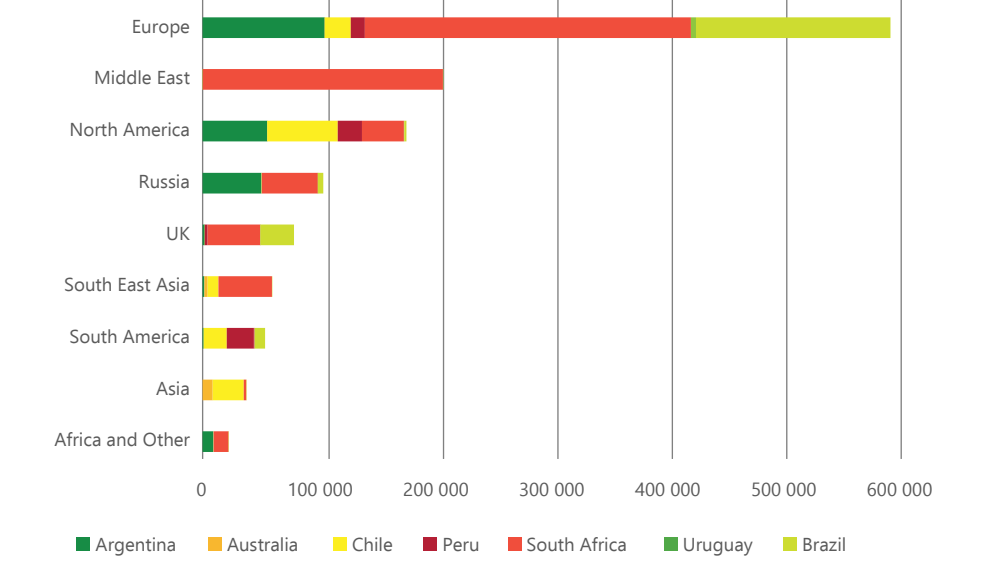
