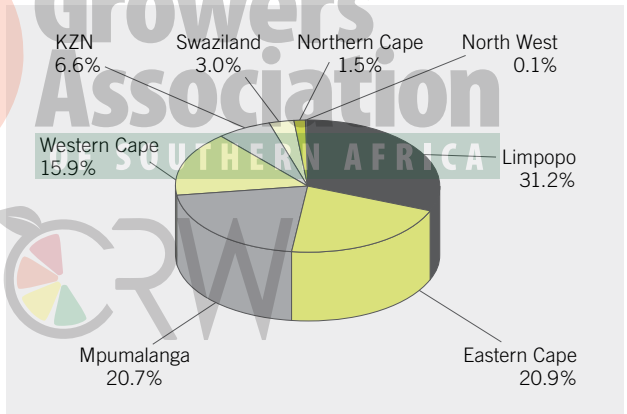

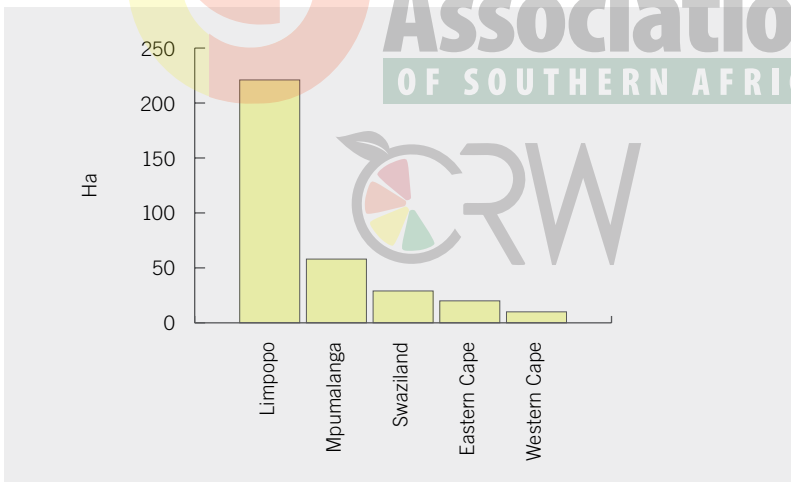

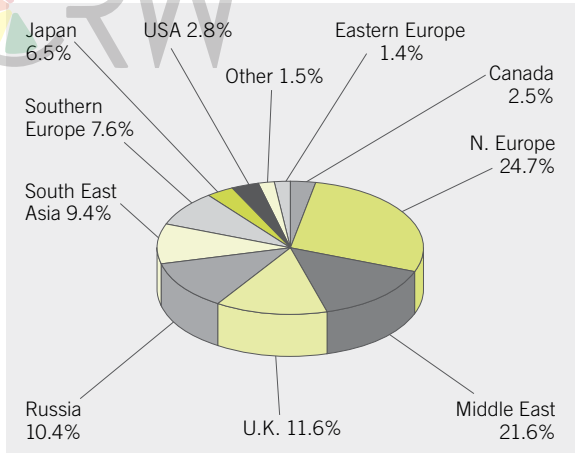
PRODUCTION SECTORS VOLUME 2009

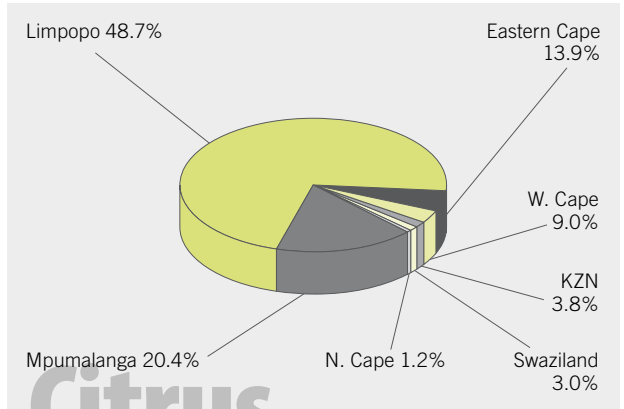

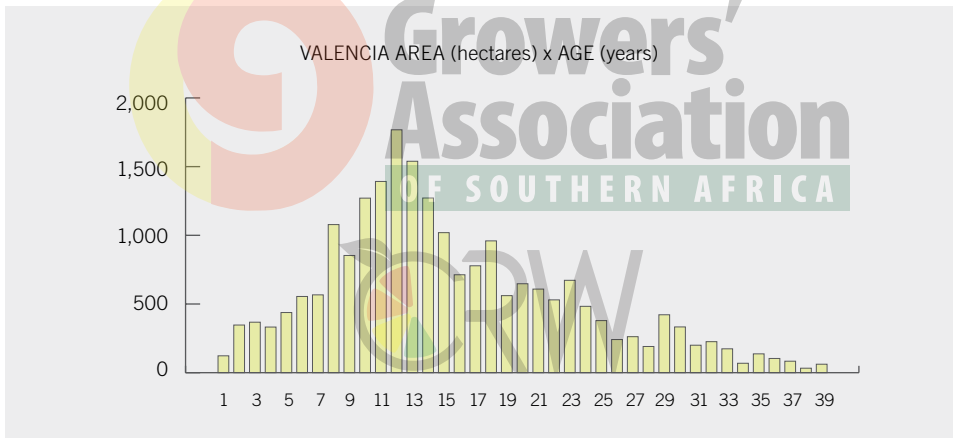

AGE CLASS DISTRIBUTION: VALENCIAS

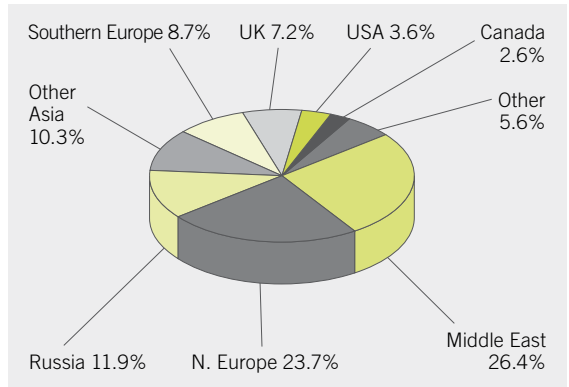

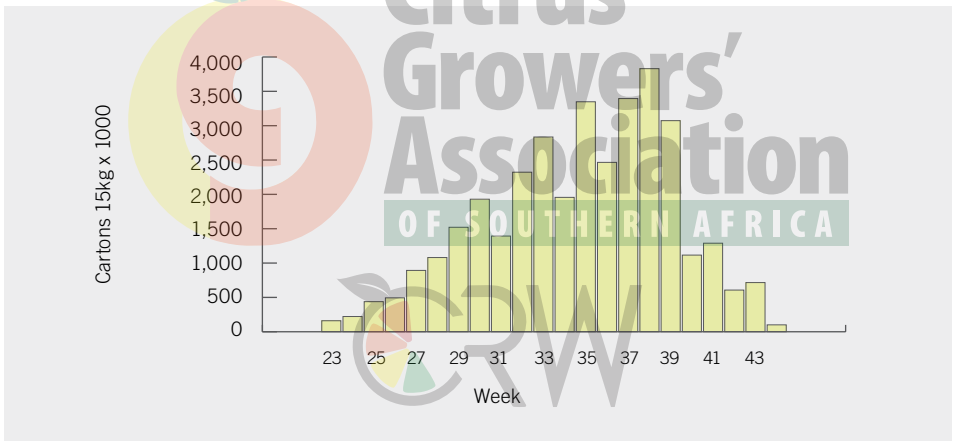

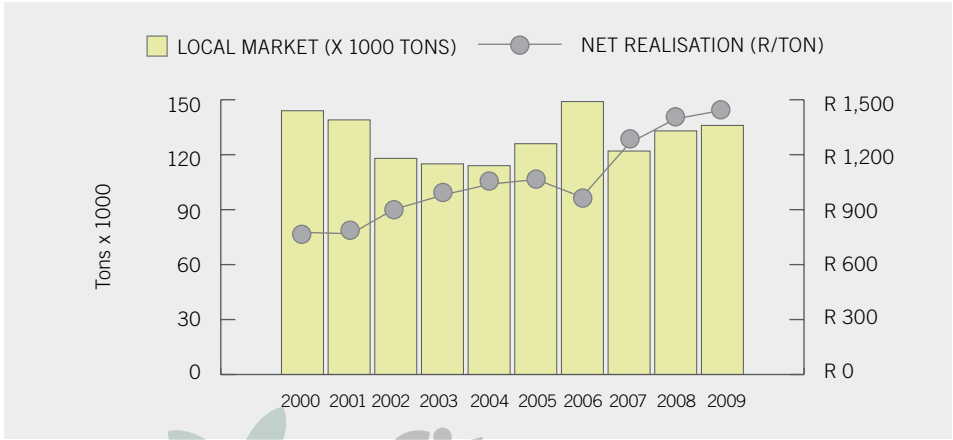
NAVELS SHIPPED 2009



VALENCIAS SHIPPED 2009

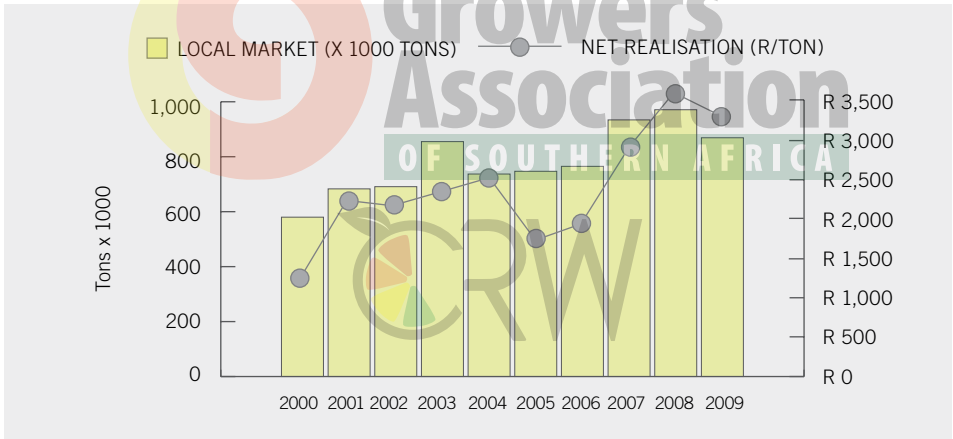


HISTORICAL SALES LOCAL

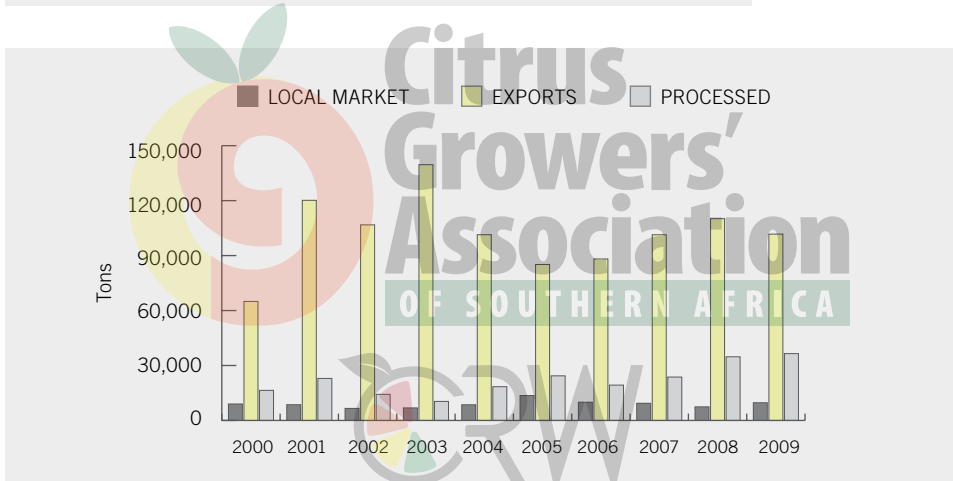
AREA PLANTED PER CULTIVAR

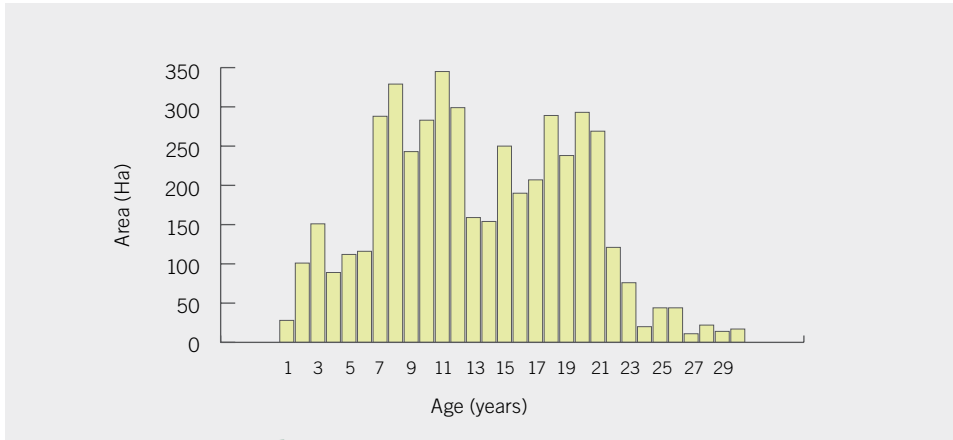

AGE DISTRIBUTION SOFT CITRUS



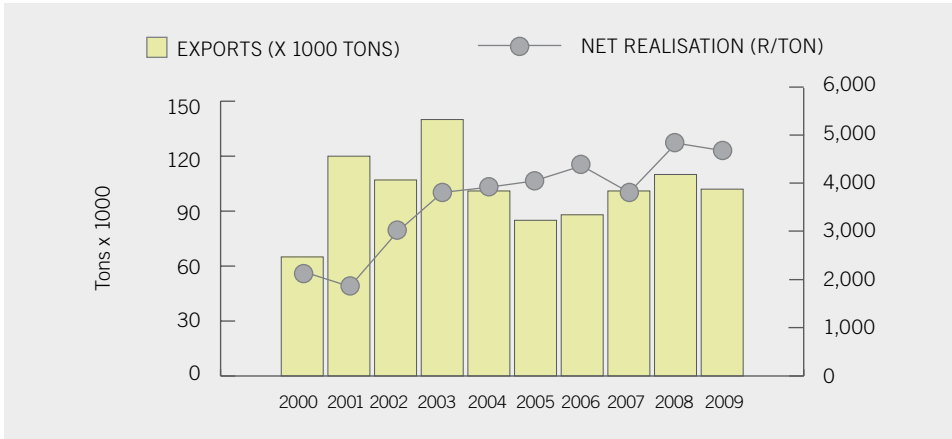

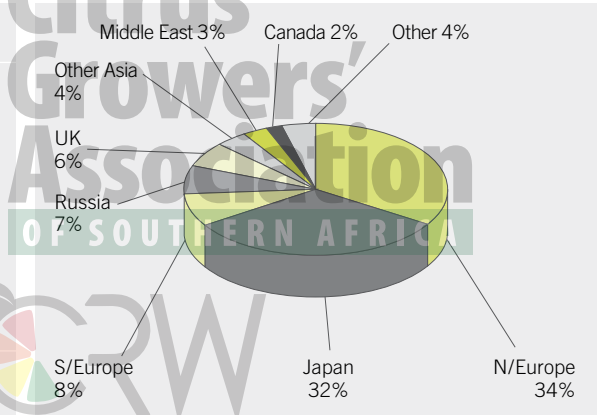

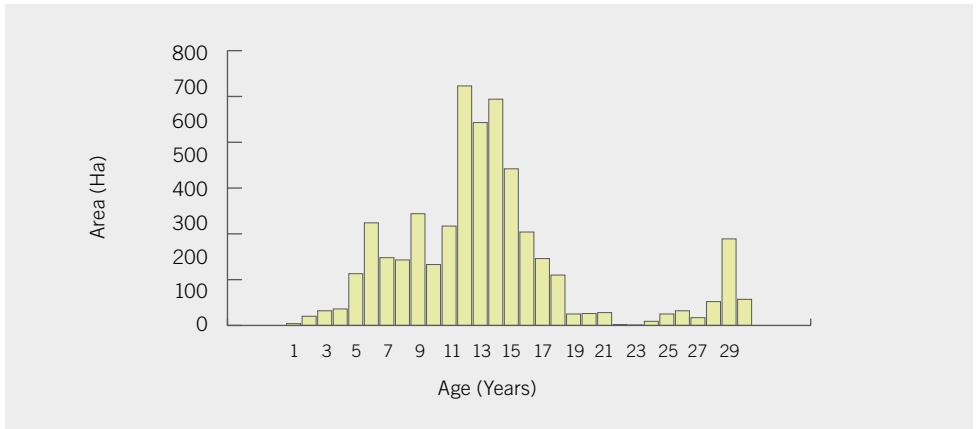

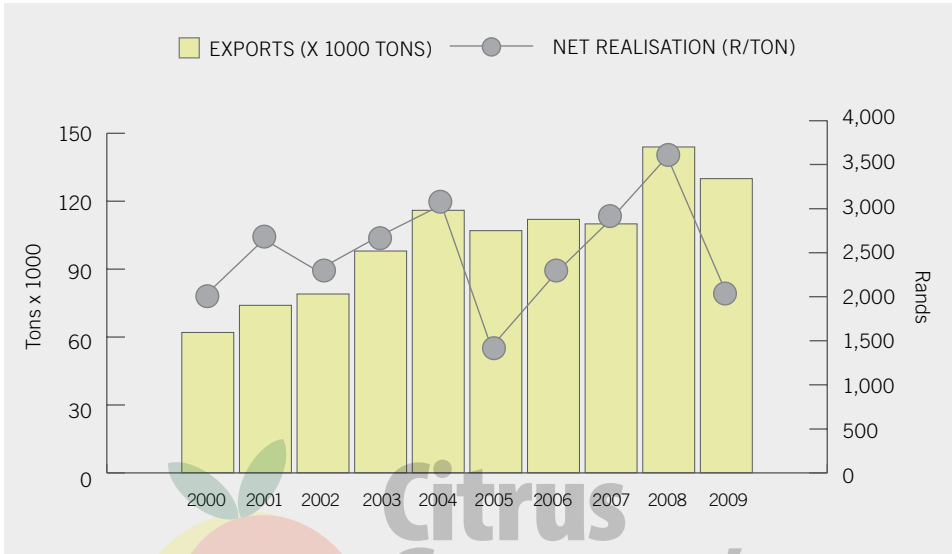
LEMONS MAJOR EXPORT DESTINATIONS 2009



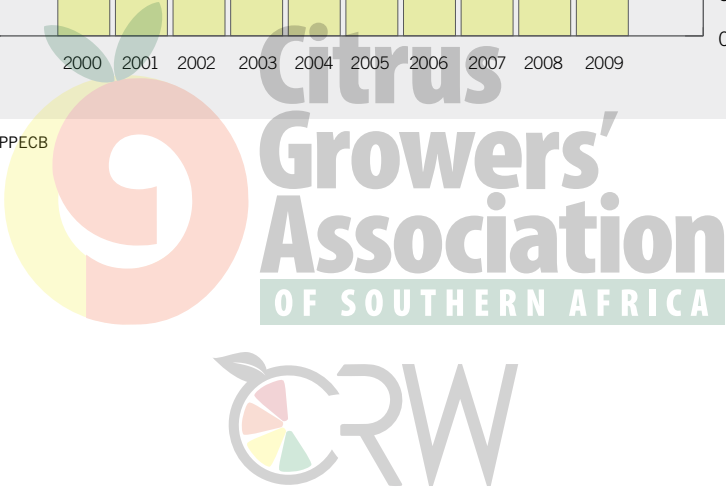
LEMONS SHIPPED 2009

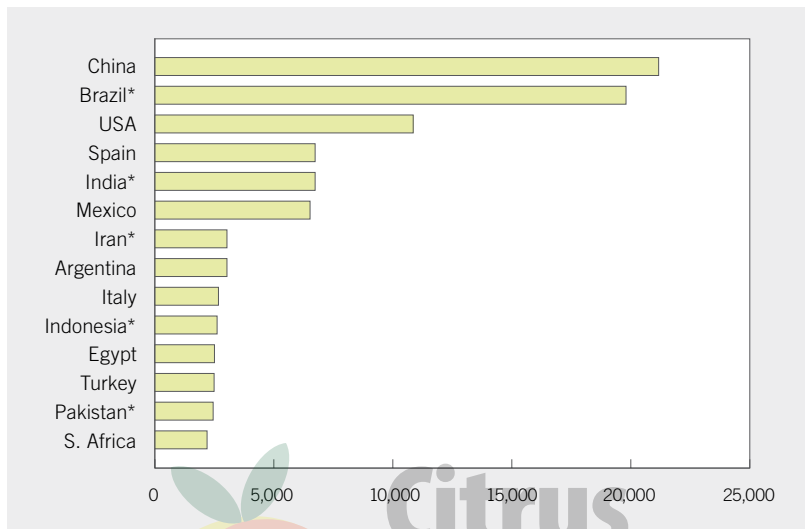
WORLD FRESH CITRUS EXPORTS (thousand tons)

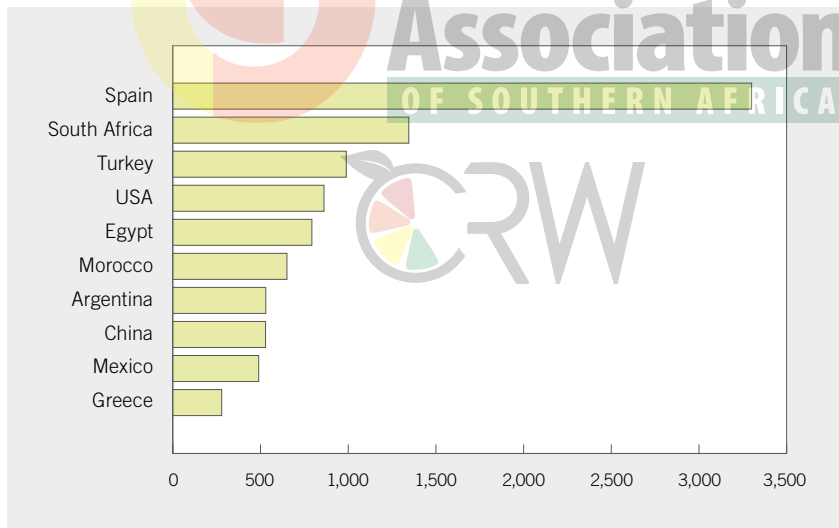

WORLD FRESH CITRUS PRODUCTION 2008/09 (thousand tons)



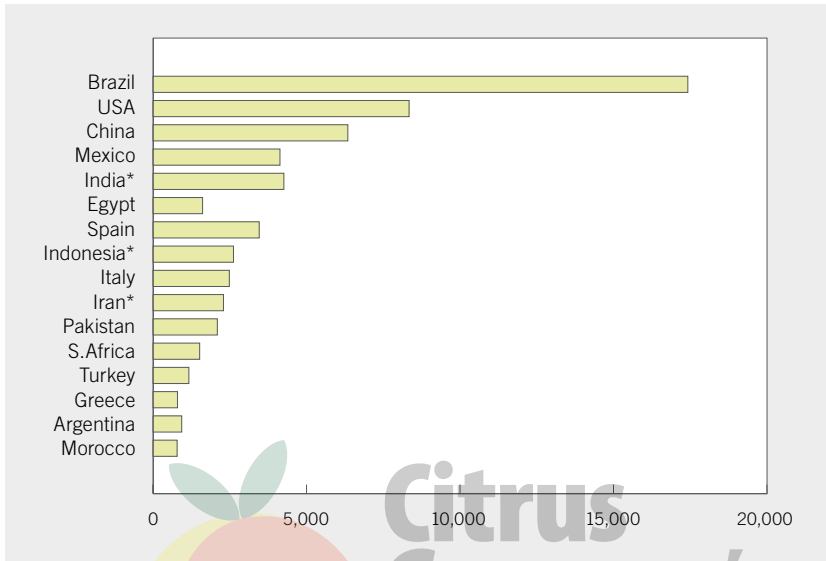

WORLD FRESH CITRUS EXPORTS 2008/09 (thousand tons)



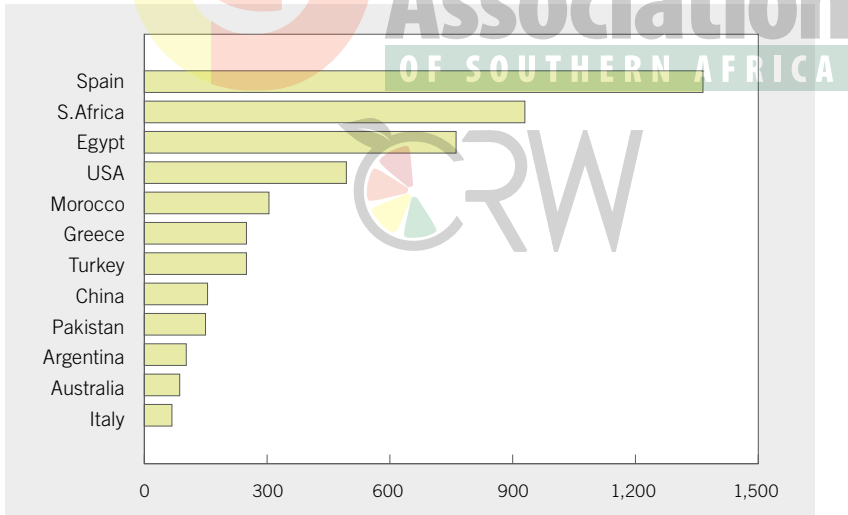

WORLD ORANGE PRODUCTION 2008/09 (thousand tons)



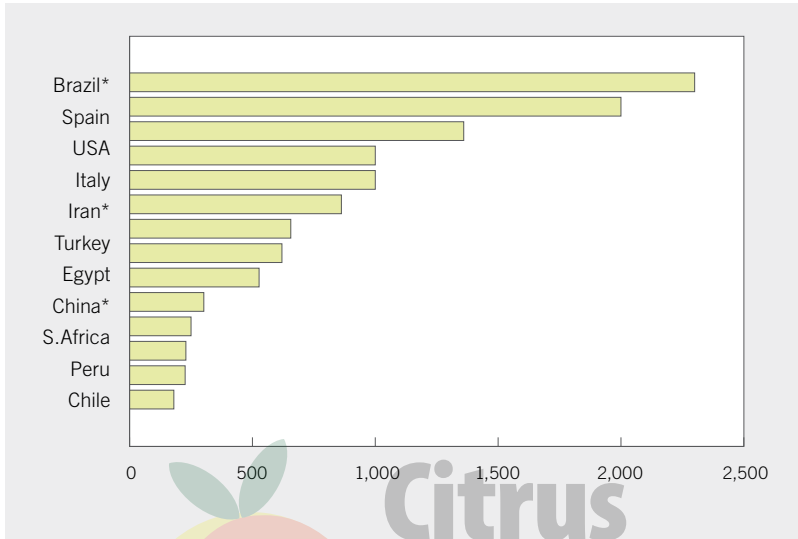

WORLD ORANGE EXPORTS 2008/09 (thousand tons)



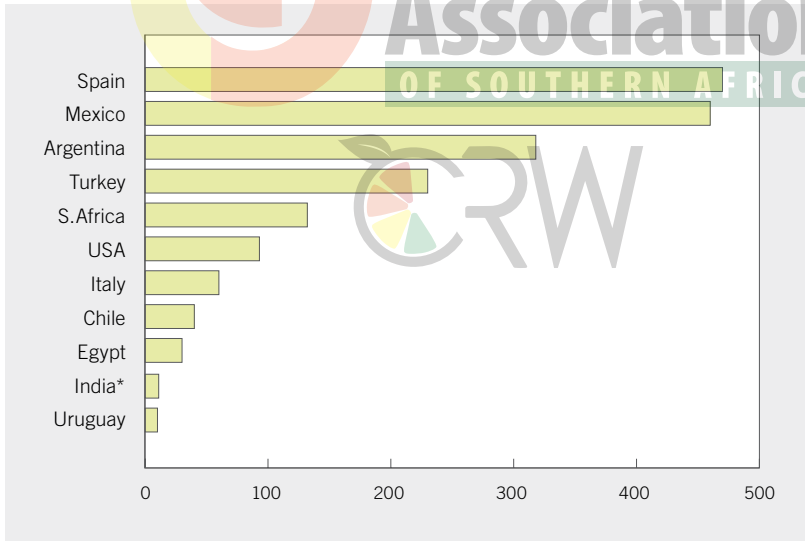

WORLD LEMON PRODUCTION 2008/09 (thousand tons)



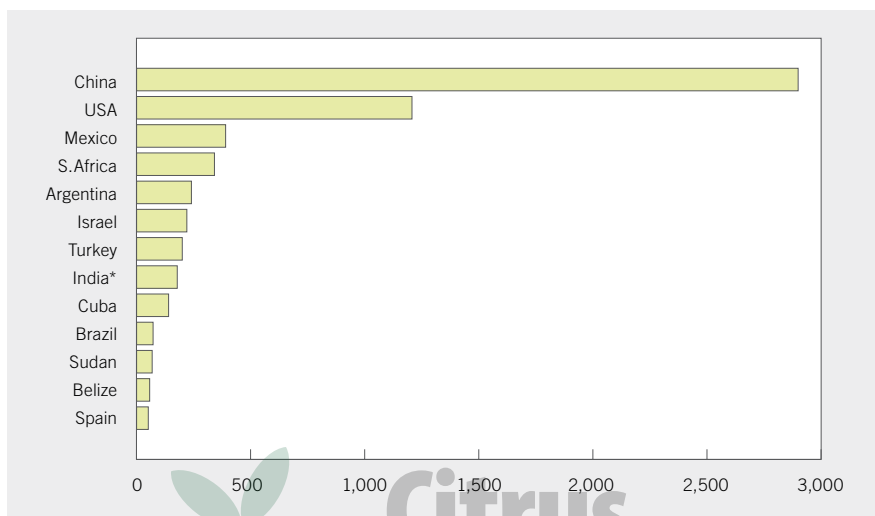

WORLD LEMON EXPORTS 2008/09 (thousand tons)

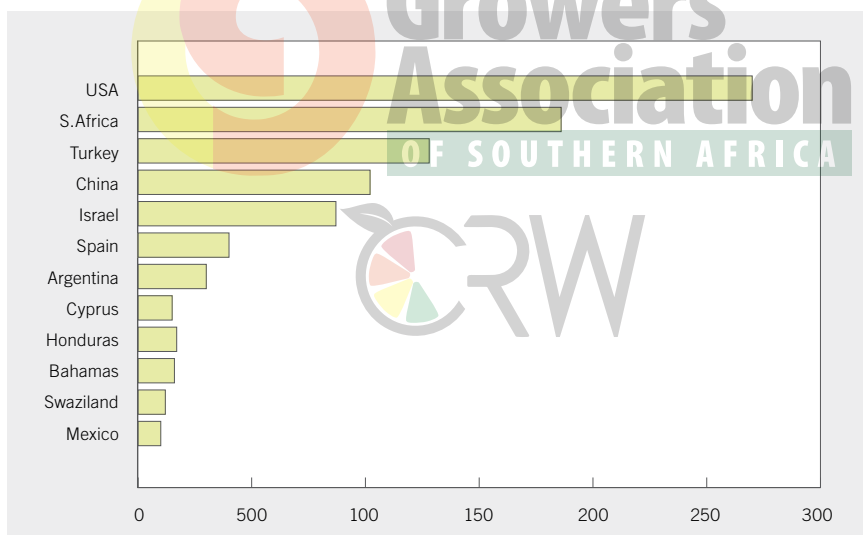

WORLD GRAPEFRUIT PRODUCTION 2008/09 (thousand tons)

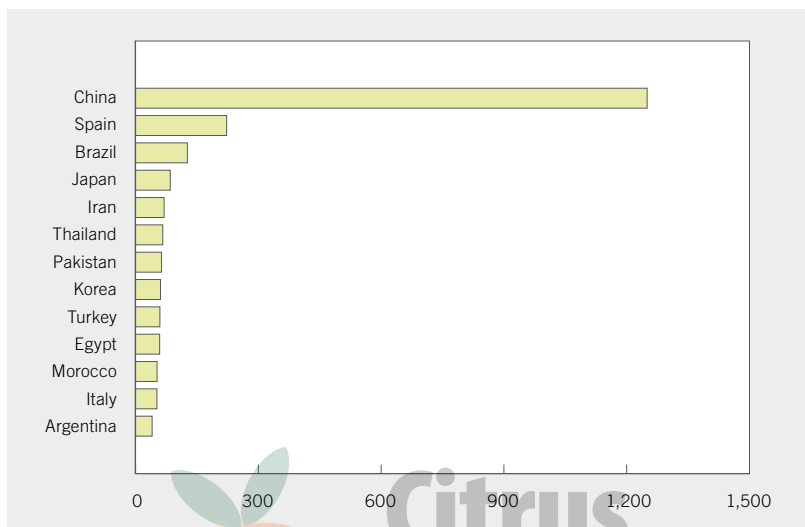


WORLD GRAPEFRUIT EXPORTS 2008/09 (thousand tons)

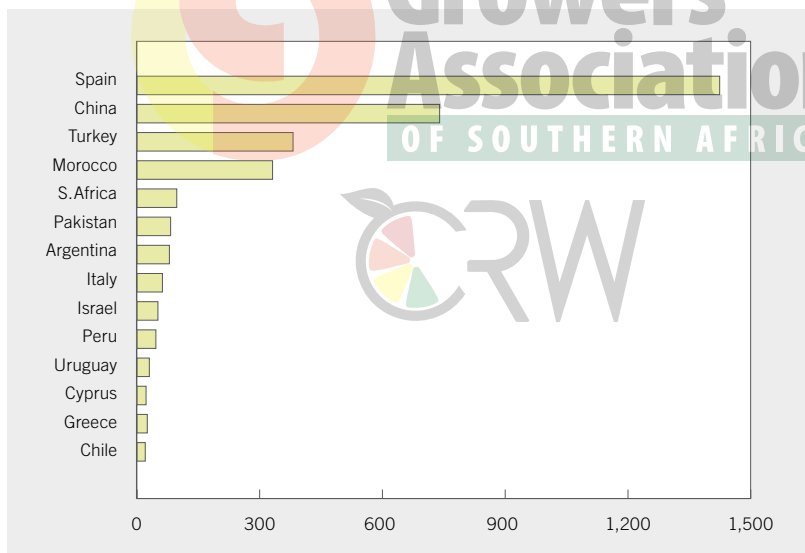




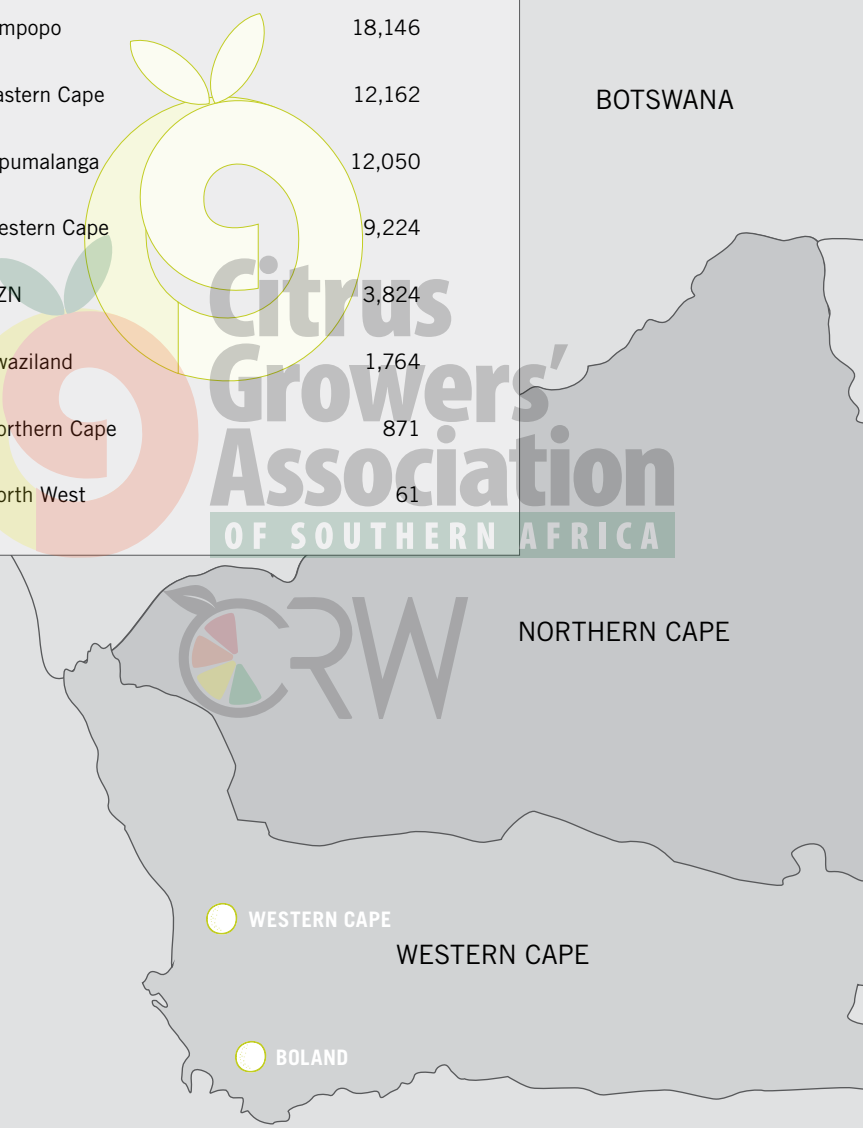
WORLD SOFT CITRUS EXPORTS 2008/09 (thousand tons)

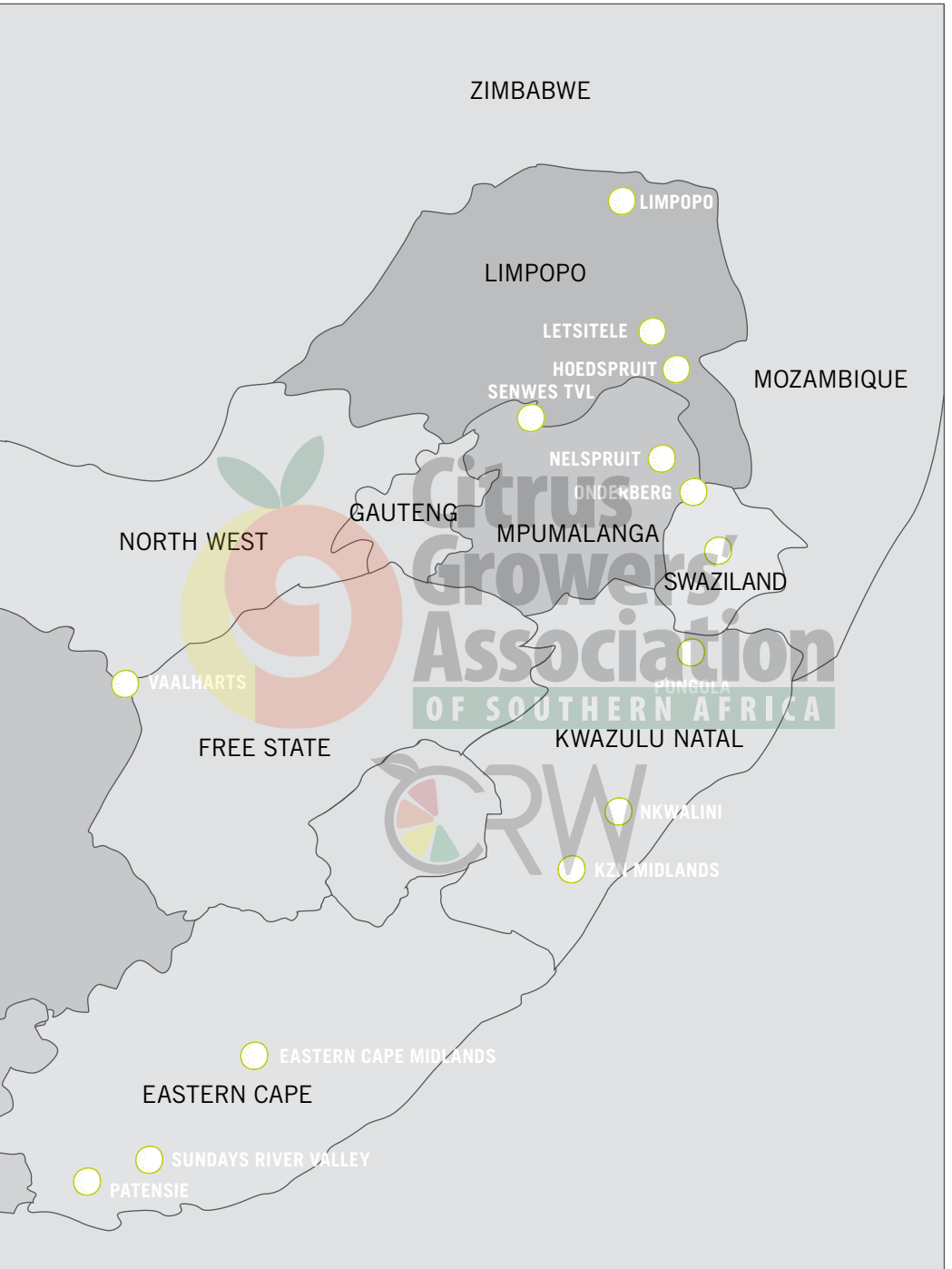

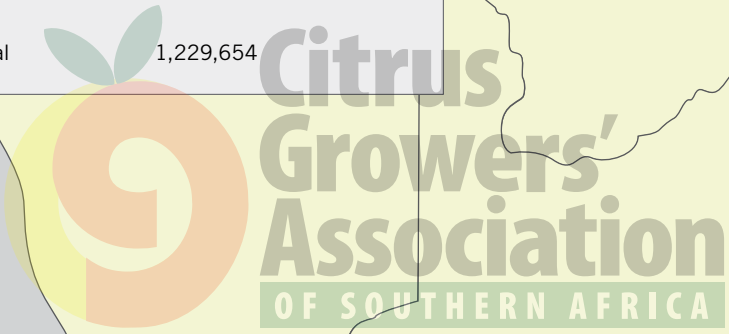
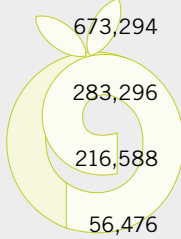
